- -At 10:07 the Bishop Deputy opened with a prayer.
- -There was a quorum (10% of the voting membership) so the vote could take place.
- -S. Moore made a motion to carry out the vote. T. Mandik 2nd the motion. Motion passed.
- -Ballots were handed out. Per the Bishop Deputy, only a "Y", "N" or "A" should be written on the ballot. "Y "for yes, "N" for no, and "A" for abstaining from voting.
- -It is required that 2/3 of the votes are "Y" in order to call Vicar Taylor Walker to be Zion's next Pastor. The number of "Y" ballots were over 2/3 of the amount needed.
- -Vicar Taylor Walker was told the results of the vote and answered yes to the call. Vicar Taylor Walker will be Zion's next Pastor.
- -Meeting was closed with a word of prayer.
